

MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING  
August 21, 2017

A regular council meeting was duly called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Mayor Dorothy Behne on Monday, August 21, 2017 with members Dorothy Behne, Kurt Olson, Brad Ringnell, Matt Larson, and Jeff Ross present. Also present City Admin/Police Chief Brad Hughes and Deputy Clerk Kym Christiansen.

Motion by Ringnell to approve the agenda, second by Olson, carried.

Motion by Olson to approve the minutes as written and sent to each council member for study, second by Ross, carried.

Consent agenda including payment of bills and pay request #12 for the water treatment project was declared approved.

Police Chief/City Admin Hughes presented a building permit for dryer being installed at the bin site on the west side of Main Street. The area is zoned properly for having a grain dryer and it was recommended that a building permit be applied for and permit has been received.

Hughes presented one quote for the removal of the building at 105 N Main Street and additional quotes will be sought. Potential funding for the removal will be sought from Martin County as well as utilizing the EDA program.

Motion by Ringnell to approve Resolution 2017-10: Adoption of Emergency Declaration to Drill New Drinking Water Supply well, second by Olson. Ringnell, yea; Olson, yea; Ross, yea; Larson, yea; D. Behne, yea. Resolution 2017-10 approved.

Administrator Report

- Fire hydrant painting will be starting soon with a focus being on Main Street and by the school for completion this year.
- Yellow curbs and white lines will be painted in the next couple of weeks once the new public works employee starts.
- League of Minnesota Cities Regional meeting will be held in New Ulm and if anyone from the Council wants to attend they should let City Hall know.
