CURBSIDE PICKUP IS AVAILABLE THIS YEAR

SATURDAY, APRIL 24, 2021

STARTING AT 8:00 AM- ITEMS MUST BE SITTING ON CURBSIDE.

Only residents who live in the City of Sherburn may participate.

- 👉 You may place items on the curb beginning Saturday, April 17th to allow for some items to be repurposed.
- 👉 **Curbside Pick up tags must be purchased at city hall or mailing to city hall. All tags must be purchased by April 22nd. Cost is \$20**
- 👉 No waste from non-residential customers, contractors, businesses!
- 👉 Tag must be placed by items on Curb
- 👉 There will still be trucks behind City Hall as in years past that will be free of charge to haul your waste to if you do not want to purchase curb-side.

WHAT WILL BE ACCEPTED?

YES

- 👉 General Non-Hazardous Waste "junk"
- 👉 Furniture items (Couches, Chairs, Tables, Mattresses, Box Springs, etc.)
- 👉 **Small** amounts of re-modeling materials (siding, dried out paint cans, drywall, carpet, etc.)
- 👉 Any and all appliances
- 👉 Auto batteries and scrap metal

All items should fit in a 5 foot by 10 foot area no higher than 4 feet. If more than this, additional tags need to be purchased.

NO

- 👉 Electronics
- 👉 Loose Shingles
- 👉 Tires
- 👉 Asbestos
- 👉 Batteries (including flashlight and rechargeable batteries)
- 👉 Chemical Products (including herbicides, pesticides)
- 👉 Fluorescent tubes and light bulbs
- 👉 Hazardous, industrial, or infectious waste
- 👉 Liquid waste, paints, thinners, removers
- 👉 Oils, oil rags, any type of drilling waste
- 👉 Radioactive materials naturally occurring (NORM)
- 👉 Yard waste (grass clippings, tree and shrub waste)
