

MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING  
August 7, 2017

A regular council meeting was duly called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Mayor Dorothy Behne on Monday, August 7, 2017 with members Dorothy Behne, Kurt Olson, Brad Ringnell, Matt Larson, and Jeff Ross present. Also present City Admin/Police Chief Brad Hughes and Deputy Clerk Kym Christiansen.

Motion by Ringnell to approve the agenda, second by Olson, carried.

Motion Ross to approve the minutes as written and sent to each council member for study, second by Olson, carried.

Consent agenda including payment of bills was declared approved.

City Admin/Police Chief Hughes presented a quote from Ziegler CAT for repairs on the generators located Temperance Lake Ridge and the Wastewater Treatment Plant. The total cost of the repairs is \$8,520.71 with the biggest expense being the control panel on the generator at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Motion by Ringnell to approve the quote from Ziegler for repairs to generators located at Temperance Lake Ridge and Wastewater Treatment Plant for \$8,520.71, second by Olson, carried.

Motion by Ringnell to move the first meeting in September to September 5 due to the Labor Day Holiday, second by Olson, carried.

Administrator Report

- Temperance Lake Lift Station Pump was put in by a company that is no longer in business and the new pump will be installed by a company that has replaced the other lift station pump. The pump would last about 20 years.
- One quote has been received for a broaster that the Liquor Store and additional quote are being sought along with information on the cost of the chicken and oil.
- Temperance Lake Ridge Financials were presented
- Presented a design for the fire hydrants around town. It was the consensus of the council to have the design on the downtown hydrants and the remaining hydrants would be white with a red cap.

In other business, Councilor Ringnell asked the creation of the maintenance and fuel log for the city equipment, which would be available for council review. Councilor Ross asked the daily work logs for the Public Works Department, if a cross walk could be put in by Dollar General from the bike path, and if the tractor and blower purchase has been finalized. Councilor Larson asked if the dump truck was going to be sold or not.

Motion to adjourn by Olson, second by Ross, carried. Meeting declared adjourned at 5:56 p.m.
