

MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING
September 17, 2018

A regular council meeting was duly called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Mayor Dorothy Behne on Monday, September 17, 2018 with members Dorothy Behne, Matt Larson, Kurt Olson, Brad Ringnell and Jeff Ross present. Also present City Admin/Police Chief Brad Hughes and Deputy Clerk Kym Christiansen.

In open public comment, Carlee Hunter asked about a request for funds for a demolition of home that she hopes to purchase at the Tax Forfeiture sale.

Motion by Ringnell to approve the agenda, second by Olson, carried.

Motion by Ringnell to approve the minutes as amended, second by Ross, carried.

Consent agenda including payment of bills was declared approved.

Motion by Ross to approve Resolution 2018-11 Adopting a Proposed 2018 Tax Levy in the Amount of \$556,617, Collectible in 2019 and Setting the Date and Time for the Public Hearing on December 3, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. and if necessary, a continuation hearing on December 17, 2018 at 6:00 p.m., second by Ringnell. Ross, yea; Ringnell, yea; Olson, yea; Larson, yea; Behne, yea. Resolution 2018-11 approved.

Administrator Report

- Designing Signs will be here this week to review the center portion of the east and west entrance signs for the new sign that will be installed. The signs poles will be painted as part of the Martin County West gives back day. The north sign will be replaced to match the signs on the east and west sides.
- Request for dust control on Lynn St due to the high number of cars that use that street
- Township completed so work on South Street and City will be getting a few loads of gravels for the street.

Councilor Ross asked about the status of the repair work being done at the theater as well as the status of light poles for Main St. Ross also asked about the status of 105 N Main St in relation to the court date. Councilor Larson asked about the status of the cooler at the liquor store. Mayor Behne stated that the windows on the liquor store will be painted this fall as part of the downtown beautification project.
