

MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING
September 7, 2021

A regular council meeting was duly called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Mayor Bob Roesler on Tuesday, September 7, 2021 with members Carlee Hunter, Matt Larson Kurt Olson, Brad Ringnell, and Bob Roesler present. Also present City Admin/Police Chief Brad Hughes and Deputy Clerk Kym Christiansen.

Motion by Ringnell to approve the agenda as amended, second by Larson, carried.

Motion by Ringnell to approve the minutes as written and sent to each council member for study, second by Olson, carried.

Consent agenda including payment of bills was declared approved following discussion on the bill received from Beemer Companies for the repair of a broken water main.

Mike Schoen was present to discuss the application of dust control on the gravel streets in the City. The City provides dust control on certain streets while the adjoining property owners pay to have the dust control done on their streets. Mr. Schoen requested that a counter be put up to see how the Cargill St is used. Mr. Schoen also stated that the storm sewer along Cargill and S Prairie is in need of replacement. No Council action was taken.

Motion by Ringnell to approve Resolution 2021-12 Pursue Obtaining the Property at 211 N Prairie St, second by Olson. Ringnell, yea; Olson, yea; Hunter, yea; Larson, yea; Roesler, yea. Resolution 2021-12 approved.

Motion by Roesler to accept the resignation of Deputy Clerk Christiansen effective September 24, 2021, second by Ringnell, carried.

City Admin/Police Chief Hughes presented information regarding a potential Veteran's Memorial for the City of Sherburn. The proposed location would be on the vacant lot south of the My Guy building. Discussion was held regarding the location of the memorial as well as additional locations. It was the consensus of the council that they are in favor of the idea but have concerns regarding the location.

Administrator Report

- Budget workshop will be held on September 14 at 5:00 p.m.

In other business, Councilor Hunter asked if a yield sign could be installed on the corner of Fairmont Ave and Kenzie St. Councilor Ringnell stated that there are several locations around the city that have trees that need to be trimmed on the street side.

Motion to adjourn by Ringnell, second by Larson, carried. Meeting declared adjourned at 5:40 p.m.
