Administrator Report:

- -Bar and Off-Sale will be open on Mondays from 3-11, with the kitchen still closed. Taking applications for manager until November 24th, then interview process will begin. Keg Cooler needs to be replaced, 2 estimates from Day Plumbing were received. Plan is to pay for this with a loan from TLR fund.
- -Money Transfers need to be made from Northland Security Funds. Council members and Mayor wanted to know if there would be any lost interest if funds are pulled early. Suggestion made by Ringnell to take from the TLR Operating funds.

Public Works Report:

-Reported that we are waiting on the electric for the WWTP project. Solid waste has been applied with the help of Tom Finke. UV room was shut down and cleaned. Main Street decorations have been started and will be finished up this week.
